- Modify the look and feel of the Player
- Add narration by recording or importing audio
- Increase user interactivity with click, highlight, and text entry boxes
- Add interest by inserting rollovers
- Insert question and scoring slides
- Create interest by branching to different Slides and Scenes
- Import PowerPoint slides into a project
- Creating hyperlinks to websites and to another project
- Publish your project to HTML5, SWF files, and mobile devices
- Publish to LMS with reporting and tracking options

Important Note: This is a Bring-Your-Own-Device (BYOD) Workshop. You will need a laptop with Articulate Storyline installed. If you do not have Storyline, you can install a fully functional 30-day free trial prior to the class.
